## What is the Maryland Native Plants Program?

Established through the Maryland Native Plants Program Act (HB950/SB836, 2023), the MNPP is a first-of-its-kind initiative designed to:

- Promote the use of true Maryland native plants
- Support certified native plant nurseries and growers MARYLAND
- Educate consumers, gardeners, and professionals

According to Maryland state law (HB950/SB836, 2023), a native plant is defined as:

A plant that occurs naturally in the state and surrounding region, ecosystem, and habitat, without direct or indirect human actions.

#### **Voluntary Nursery** Certification

- A three-tier program recognizing nurseries that carry Maryland native plants:
  - Bronze (20–49%)
  - Silver (50-74%)
  - Gold (75–100%)
- Certification helps consumers find more native plant options
- Look for the "Maryland's Best Native Plants" logo when shopping
