

# Deeply Rooted in Winter Sowing

A method to grow hardy native plants from seed

1

Collect & wash jugs. Discard caps.



2

Punch 4-6 drainage holes in the bottom.



3

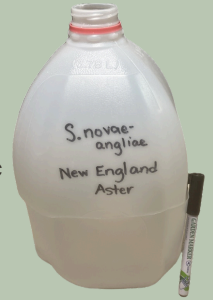
Cut jug in half leaving a hinge at the handle.



4

Label outside with weather resistant marker.

Recommended:  
Also label a plastic plant stake to place in soil



5

Put 3-4 inches of pre-moistened grow mix in bottom of jug.



6

Scatter seeds on top of grow mix and press in lightly. Carefully water to ensure contact w/ soil.



7

Tape the jug closed with painter's or duct tape.



8

Set jugs outside where rain & snow can enter top. Water if needed.



9

Open jug in spring after seeds sprout & danger of frost ends.



10

Up-pot or plant when seedlings are at least 2" tall. Keep watered & enjoy your homegrown plants!
